The successful candidate is expected to:

- have a Ph.D. degree in archaeogenetics (defended dissertation no later than 1st of January 2022).
- Field of specialisation is European Neolithic to Bronze Age; already realised projects and accepted publications are needed.
- Good oral and written communication skills in English and experience with working in an international, interdisciplinary research environment are essential.
