Institute of Archaeology of the Czech Academy of Sciences, Prague, would like to announce the 12<sup>th</sup> year of the Jan Rulf Award for the best scientific publication in the field of archaeology and related fields. The competition is open to young researchers. Authors or an institution may submit articles and publications. One institution may submit a maximum of five publications in each category (up to five publications or PhD theses and five Master's and/or Bachelor's theses).

Each submitted article/publication must meet the following criteria:

- The publication must represent an original theoretical work in the field of archaeology and related fields.
- The work was either published or completed <u>between March 1<sup>st</sup>, 2021, and February 28<sup>th</sup>, 2023.</u>
- To enter the competition, the article/publication or thesis must be delivered to the Institute of Archaeology in Prague electronically (preferably in PDF to arupraha@arup.cas.cz) or in one hard copy (publication, offprint, manuscript) no later than February 28<sup>th</sup>, 2023, together with a cover letter confirming that the author(s) has/have agreed to entering the competition.
- The author <u>cannot be more than 36 years old by February 28<sup>th</sup>, 2023</u>, and must be an EU citizen. If more than one author cooperated in writing the article/publication, all authors must meet this condition.
- The submitted publications must be written in Czech or English.

The results will be announced on the Institute of Archaeology website by June 1<sup>st</sup>, 2023. For more information, see the attachment.
