The distribution of copper, salt and iron: recent research on the exploitation of Eastern Alpine resources in prehistory

Archaeological research into mineral resources of the Eastern Alps has a longstanding and successful history. Especially the copper ore and the salt underground mines with their excellent conditions of preservation have attracted generations of scholars. In recent years, new research projects shed light on the processing and distribution of these resources during the Bronze and Iron Age. In this lecture, I am going to present new fieldwork and recent discoveries from Upper Austria and Tyrol that can be regarded as the 'missing link' between miners and consumers of copper, salt and iron.

The lecture will take place hybridly, physically in the library of the Institute of Archaeology of the CAS, Prague and simultaneously on Zoom.
