43rd Annual Archaeological Conference "Problems of the Neolithic and Eneolithic" Praha-Vinoř / 25th–27th September 2024

Conference orientation program:

The **abstract** (in a separate Word file) should not exceed 150 words, equal to approximately 1000 characters, including spaces and punctuation. Please ensure that both versions of the abstract adhere to the specified length limit.

We kindly remind you to adhere to the **specified time limit** of 15 minutes for your presentations. For the student section and field research, the time limit is 10 minutes.
